- Founded in 1951, the Society—named after the first Catholic Bishop in the United States—is dedicated to the service of the Archbishop of Washington.
- The Society includes lay men and women drawn from all areas of the professional and business life in the Metropolitan Washington Area.
- The Society promotes the enhancement of spiritual, intellectual and social fellowship among its members and guests.
- The Society organizes the annual Red Mass prior to the opening of the Supreme Court's judicial year, at St. Matthew's Cathedral on the Sunday before the first Monday in October, and the Annual Rose Mass for health care professionals on the fourth Sunday of Lent at Little Flower Church.
- The Society sponsors periodic events featuring outstanding speakers who address topics of current interest in conjunction with Mass and Sunday brunch. The Society also sponsors an annual dinner.
- The Society encourages First Friday devotion which includes Mass, Confession, fellowship and a theological reflection. The Society also sponsors a Fall Retreat and an annual Lenten Day of Recollection.
- The Society assists the Archbishop in his works of charity and other community projects.
- The Society cultivates a love for the ministry and mission of the Holy Father by making available to members documents issued by the Holy See intended to strengthen the Faith. Pilgrimages are also planned each year.
