AWARDS

In memory of JCS member, Margaret Mary Missar, the High School Essay Scholarship Awards are as follows:

One First Place Winner	\$2,000
One Second Place Winner	\$1,000
Two Third Place Winners	\$500 each
Up to Ten Honorable Mention Winners	\$100 each

At least one student from each school submitting 10 or more essays will receive an Honorable Mention award. Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the winners' respective schools for credit towards their 2019-2020 tuition.

ESSAY CONTEST INSTRUCTIONS

- Essays must be original work, expositive in nature, in double-space type, 1200-1500 words total, and with proper citations to any sources.
- Please submit three copies of each essay.
- Each copy of the essay must include:
 - a cover sheet that includes the student's name, year of graduation, school, home address, and home phone number. The back of cover sheet must be left blank.
 - Please do not include the student's name or school's name on any page other than the cover sheet.
- We ask that the essays be collected by the high school and sent in one package.
- Essays will be judged by a distinguished panel of JCS members
- Judging will be based on scholarship, originality, writing and rhetorical skill, and coverage of the topic. Judges' decisions are final.
